Shooting Ranges – Open Year Round to Members Only

Our rifle and pistol ranges are open year round to members only. Range hours are from 9:00am – 7:00pm. We have covered firing lines at both ranges - our rifle range is 100+ yards and the pistol range is 50 yards. We provide target frames, trash and empty shell containers. Please utilize these containers and keep our ranges clean and neat. Please remember to place your target so that bullets strike the backstop and do not ricochet off the ground or pass over the backstop. Please utilize the pistol range for shooting short distances. Our target frames are designed so bullets passing through the target area will strike the backstops properly. We have also added a new berm to the left of the rifle range to reduce sound travel from the range toward our

neighbors. Thank you to all of the members for keeping the range safe and clean.
